

Who are Friendly Visitors?

Friendly Visitor volunteers are people who have a strong interest in contributing to their community's well-being.

They must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license, be able to provide proof of auto insurance, and submit to a background check through the library before they can begin volunteering.

Volunteers will have an orientation at the library before going on their first visit. A library staff person or qualified volunteer will accompany all volunteers on their first friendly visit as part of the orientation.

Friendly Visitors deliver and return materials for patrons who can not physically access the library. Volunteers may be asked to renew or check out materials, and should deliver any requests or comments made by patrons to the library on the checkout slip provided.

Volunteers are encouraged to discuss the patron's reading and community interests in order to help the library best serve the patrons' needs.

About the program

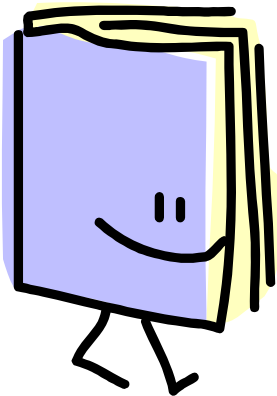
The Johnson City Public Library's Friendly Visitor Program is designed to bring library services to citizens of Johnson City who cannot reach the library due to a disability.

Anyone living in the Johnson City area that does not have physical access to the library is eligible to receive Friendly Visitor services.

Volunteers deliver books and other library materials to the patron's home, and may stay for a friendly visit.

The JCPL Friendly Visitor Program serves as a vital link between citizens, their library, and their community. The Johnson City Public Library staff and volunteers work together to deliver the library services and community information patrons need to stay connected.
